



When Are Store Terms Available on the Permanently Store Grades Screen

Purpose: Administration The Permanently Store Grades process can be used to store current grades as historical grades. Depending on the time of year that this function is used, only certain terms are available to store grades from. This article describes when those store terms are made available.

When are store terms available?

Store terms for the Permanently Store Grades process are made available 10 days after the start of a given term.

Example: If the 2007-2008 school year begins on 8/15/2007, the 2007-2008 store term will be available on the Permanently Store Grades screen on 8/26/2007.

When are store terms no longer available?

Administrators can only store grades up to 30 days after the end of a term. Store terms will no longer be available 30 days after the end of a term.

Example: If Semester 1 ends on 1/1/2008, the Semester 1 store term will no longer be available on the Permanently Store Grades screen on 1/31/2008. Administrators will no longer be able to store grades for Semester 1 after that date.
