What are the dates of the 2021 College for Kids program?

Session A: Monday, June 21 – Thursday, July 1

Session B: Tuesday, July 6 – Friday, July 16

Will the 2021 College for Kids program be held in person or virtually?

When will the Course Catalog be posted?

When will online registration begin?

Online registration will begin at 8:00 a.m. on March 31st.

What is the cost of the College for Kids program?

Per session tuition will be \$275/student.

The optional Early Bird class will be \$60/student per session.

Is financial assistance available?

How is the program structured?

Due to the Fourth of July holiday weekend, College for Kids will operate two 9-day sessions. The program is held 8:30 a.m.-12:07 p.m. daily. During the 9-day program students participate in 3 classes which meet daily for 67 minutes each.

Period 1: 8:30-9:37

Period 2: 9:45-10:52

Period 3: 11:00-12:07

(An optional Early Bird class is also offered for an additional fee, 7:25-8:20.)

How many classes can my child take?

Each student takes 3 classes as a part of the program.

Can my child register for both sessions – June (Session A) and July (Session B)?

Yes!

What COVID precautions will be in place this summer?

College for Kids intends to follow the COVID precautions recommended by local public health departments, as well as the Safe Campus policies and procedures in place at Coe College. Information will be shared with students and families upon registration, and any changes will be communicated prior to the summer sessions.

Will the Iowa City School District be providing bus service this summer?

Unfortunately, no. Bus service is expected to return for Summer 2022.

What is the average class size?

We expect the average class size to be 10 students. If classroom capacity restrictions are lifted on campus in relation to public health decisions, it is possible that our class sizes may increase to an average of 12 students.
