

# **2023 Financial Assistance Options**

Below are the resources available for families seeking financial assistance for the 2023 College for Kids Summer Enrichment Program. There are some limitations, so please review the information below thoroughly.

### **Tuition Payment Plan**

**Amount:** Full Tuition paid via installments

**Details:** 

- ✓ Requires approximately 25% deposit at time of registration
- ✓ Payments will be set up monthly (*April-May-June* or *April-May-June-July*)
- ✓ Payment due in full by July 15

#### How to request a payment plan:

When registering for College for Kids <a href="https://www.gwaea.org/college-for-kids">www.gwaea.org/college-for-kids</a> complete the following steps:

- 1. Access the *Support or Assistance Form* in Step 3 of online registration
- 2. Respond "yes" to the Tuition Payment Plan question and retrieve the discount code provided
- 3. Enter the provided discount code in Your Cart in Step 4 allowing for the deposit option

- 5. Susie will contact you shortly after registration to set up your payment installment dates

### Financial Assistance Request

**Amount:** \$145 max per student

**Details:** 

- ✓ Intended for families in need of support
- ✓ Anticipated 45 scholarships
- ✓ Covers partial tuition (families responsible for tuition/fees beyond \$145)

#### How to apply for these funds:

When registering for College for Kids www.qwaea.org/college-for-kids complete the following steps:

- 1. Access the Support or Assistance Form in Step 3 of online registration
- 2. Respond "yes" to the Tuition Payment Plan question and retrieve the discount code provided
- 3. Respond "yes" to the Financial Assistance Request question and complete the three questions that follow
- 4. Enter the provided discount code in Your Cart in Step 4 allowing for the deposit option

- 6. Susie will contact you shortly regarding your financial assistance request (and to set up any payments if necessary)

## **United Way Summership (students in Johnson & Washington Counties)**

Amount: Up to \$250/child

**Details:** 

- ✓ K-12 students residing in Johnson and Washington County who are eligible for Free & Reduced Lunch are eligible to apply for the available scholarships.
- ✓ Funds are limited A **maximum of five** Summership scholarships are available per camp or activity.
- ✓ Applications are reviewed and awarded in the order they are received.

## SAFE Grant (Cedar Rapids School District students only)

Amount: based on family need

**Details:** 

- ✓ Limited to students who attend school in the Cedar Rapids Community School District
- ✓ Intended for families in need of support
- ✓ Requires that a school district employee submit the grant application on behalf of the student.

#### How to apply for these funds:

Contact your school counseling office and indicate you would like to pursue a SAFE grant on behalf of your child to pay for your child's College for Kids tuition.
