

## SUBSTITUTE AUTHORIZATION

This course is designed to meet the requirements for the Substitute Authorization. The course addresses the four components required by the Board of Educational Examiners: Classroom Management, Strategies for Learning, Diversity, and Ethics. Participants are required to purchase the Substitute Teacher Handbook, https://mylearning.stedi.org/product/ handbook prior to the course start date. Access to a device with a microphone and camera and high speed internet is necessary to complete this course.

Full participation in all Zoom instructional sessions and completion of five hours of online instruction and assignments are required for this course.

Upon successful completion of the program the participant may apply to the Board of Educational Examiners for authorization to substitute teach. lowa licensure also requires a state and federal background check. Receiving a Substitute Authorization will allow an individual to substitute Pre-K—12. Additional licensure application and background check fees will apply.
