# What are the dates of the 2022 College for Kids program?

Session A: Tuesday, June 21 – Friday, July 1 Session B: Tuesday, July 5 – Friday, July 15

#### Will the 2022 College for Kids program be held in person?

The 2022 College for Kids Summer Enrichment Program will be held on the campus of Coe College in Cedar Rapids.

#### When will the Course Catalog be posted?

The Course Catalog will be posted in mid-February, and will include course titles, course descriptions and class periods/times available. Limited space is available per class period.

# When will online registration begin?

Online registration will begin at 8:00 a.m. on March 1.

# What is the cost of the College for Kids program?

Per session tuition will be \$285/student.

The optional Early Bird class will be \$65/student per session.

#### Is financial assistance available?

## How is the program structured?

College for Kids will operate two nine-day sessions. The program is held 8:30 a.m.-12:07 p.m. daily. During the nine-day program students participate in three (3) classes which meet daily for 67 minutes each.

Period One: 8:30-9:37 Period Two: 9:45-10:52 Period Three: 11:00-12:07

(An optional Early Bird class is also offered for an additional fee, 7:25-8:20.)

# How many classes will my child participate in as part of the program?

Each student takes three classes as a part of the program.
